## Implementation of Regional Football Associations Competitions

Pursuant to the resumption of the Regional Football Associations Competitions at all levels under the auspices of the Regional Football Associations, EFA wishes to guide and direct that all participating teams, their players and officials of the regional leagues' competitions, will be subject to the mandatory screening for Covid-19, as per the directives of the EFA Medical Committee. In this regard, EFA, through the Medical Committee had already commenced the implementation of Covid-19 workshops for all the Regional Football Associations.

In view of the above, Regional Associations will be expected to request for Covid-19 workshops for all groups of teams, as they resume their competitions matches for the 2021/2022 season. competitions organizers are further encouraged to assure observance of the Covid-19 protocols as matches are being implemented countrywide.

EFA would like to further recognize and express appreciativeness to the ongoing competitions matches at the regional associations, which exhibits the capacity and maturity existing within the wider football family as it assures the survival of its revered industry that had been missed by the masses of Eswatini populace.
