Ordinary General Assembly 2022 Notice

Notice is hereby given to all Members of the EFA, in terms of Article 29 (2) of the EFA Statutes, that the Ordinary General Assembly 2022 will be held on Sunday, 21st August 2022, at a venue and time to be communicated in due course, in conformity with the EFA Statutes.

Proposals to the Ordinary General Assembly

Members are also hereby informed that proposals to the Ordinary General Assembly must have been submitted to the EFA Secretariat (*General Secretary*) by the 21st July 2022, at the latest, in conformity with the EFA Statutes in Articles 30 (1) and 32 (2).

Delegates to the Ordinary General Assembly

Delegates' numbers shall be as enshrined in Article 24 (1) a) to e) of the EFA Statutes *i.e.* a maximum of six (6) delegates for Premier League of Eswatini; each of the four (4) Regional Football Associations, the Referees Association; the Coaches Association; and the Women Football Association.

Members are also expected to observe the dictates of Article 24 (2).
