Exclusive extension of the 2022/2023 Second Window Registration Period

EFA Members and Leagues, are hereby informed that, as an exclusive arrangement and contemplation, of the reported challenges of travelling experienced countrywide as a result of the torrential rainstorms that varying instances damaged and inhibited the passage channels, being a considered force majeure circumstance, the Second Window Registration Period for football clubs and exclusively, the domestic transfers and registration of players, under the jurisdiction of EFA, is extended from the original 10th February 2023, to now close, by close of business on Friday, 17th February 2023.

In view of the above, this exclusive extension, only affects the domestic registration and transfers of players; with the international transfers of players still remaining to close as originally regulated this 10th February 2023. All other regulated timelines, in respect of players allowed to register outside the second window registration period remain unchanged, as promulgated through Circular No. 183 of the 28th July 2022.

All football clubs in the membership of EFA, affected by this environmental interruption, are therefore expected to have concluded their registration business by the new stipulated deadline (17th February 2023), irrespective of any inclement weather that may become incidental or the persistence of the rains, in which instance they must find alternative remedies to finalize their registration business within the new period. *They are further encouraged to discharge their respective registration and associated business as early as possible to avoid clubs being locked out for the rest of the season, as there will be no other extraordinary consideration beyond this extended period. This exclusive extension does not set any form of precedence or reference for future, as all football clubs and stakeholders are always expected to conform to stipulated timelines in the discharge of their business.*
