Compulsory FIFA/EFA Connect Platform Registration for football clubs and players

FIFA, through the FIFA Regulations for the Status and Transfer of Players, specifically, the March 2020 FIFA edition, now statutorily directs that all clubs playing football under the auspices of each member association in the membership of FIFA, must be registered electronically, through an electronic registration system recognized and approved by FIFA.

In view of this statutory obligation to be complied with by all FIFA member associations, all football clubs and players under the auspices of EFA shall in the forthcoming 2023/2024 season, be registered via the FIFA/EFA Connect platform.

To assure that appropriate expert knowledge is available for the execution of this registration statutory obligation, EFA through the EFA Licensing and International Affairs Department had already started the integration of all football clubs and players under her auspices, into the FIFA/EFA Connect Platform, including the implementation of applicable workshops to train the football clubs' users and registration officers on the FIFA/EFA electronic registration and associated regulations.

Registration officers, football clubs and players are expected to observe this statutory requirement

Details on the registration of players and football clubs for the 2023/2024 football season are as directed in Circular No. 195 of the 17th July 2023.
