## Registration Implementation Arrangements during the Festive Season Holidays

EFA members, their respective leagues and football clubs are hereby informed that in view of the scheduling of football competitions, during the festive season, whilst the EFA offices are still closed, are informed that arrangements have been made to implement the registration of players and clubs, coaches and others, as follows:

- In view of the fact that the registration of players and football clubs at the Premier League, National First Division League and Regional Super League, is executed electronically, via the FIFA Connect Registration Platform, their registration will still be done during these holidays, with EFA staff dedicated for the licensing and registration, working from home. Football clubs can therefore continue to upload all registration or licensing documentation electronically within the system for the due authorization processes which are going to be addressed from home.
- Printing and collection of licenses and playing cards that would have been concluded during the holidays' period of electronic registration, will therefore be done between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2021, at the EFA Offices. ***There will be no other time allocated to the registration and licensing of players until the reopening of the offices on the 7<sup>th</sup> January 2021.***
- Other leagues are to execute their registrations as directed by their respective regional football associations, in line with the regulations, decisions and directives of EFA on the subject.

EFA Members, their respective leagues and football clubs are therefore expected to take note of this development and accordingly implement their registration.
