Co-option of a Woman Member into the Executive Committee of Eswatini Football Association

Members of Eswatini Football Association (EFA) are hereby informed that Article 35 (4) of the EFA Statutes, provides that; in the event a woman or female candidate has not been elected into the Executive Committee, the Executive Committee shall co-opt a woman as an additional member in compliance with the requirements for Executive Committee Members as prescribed in Article 35 (6) of the EFA Statutes.

The EFA Elections 2021 results indicate that no woman was elected.

The EFA Executive Committee, in compliance with the EFA Statutes, at its Executive Committee of the 27th July 2021, co-opted Ms. Cindy Dlodlu, as a Member of the EFA Executive Committee with immediate effect for the current period of the Executive Committee (2021 - 2025).

At this instance, EFA would like to express its congratulatory note to Ms. Dlodlu on her co-option into the Executive Committee and supplementary extends its best biddings of prosperity as she executes her accountabilities in the governance and development of the game of football.
